HUD Monitoring

In May, the Department of Housing and Urban Development conducted a programmatic review (monitoring) of the Tarrant County Homeless Coalition's four federal grants: CoC Planning, HMIS (Homeless Management Information System), Coordinated Entry, and Coordinated Entry – Field Ops. The monitoring report stated that TCHC had no findings, no concerns, and was exemplary in two aspects of its work.

The independent audit of TCHC's 2016 corporate finances was similarly clean (again this year). On the strength of the financial audit and program monitoring report, HUD cancelled a financial monitoring of TCHC that had been planned for July. Recipients of any sized federal award are subject to programmatic and financial monitoring during and after the performance period of the grant.
